March 17, 2021 – *The Home Place: memoirs of a colored man's love affair with nature*, J. Drew Lanham.

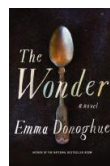
The 2021 Longwood Gardens Community Reads selection.

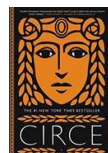
